



## Mountain States Hockey Adult Marathon Rules

- Marathon games will start on Friday, Jan 1<sup>st</sup> and conclude on Sunday Jan 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- Format will be two divisions (Intermediate and Advanced). Actual number of teams will determine the format. Final point standings will determine the division champions.
- Each team will play four games.
- Wins will receive 2 points, Ties receive 1 point, and shutouts receive an additional point. Teams with two or fewer penalties (too many men and delay of game excluded) in a game will also receive 1 point.
- In the event of a tie for seeding, the first tie breaker will be based on the winner of the prior head to head competition. Should additional tie breakers be needed, the team with the fewest total penalty minutes in the marathon will be the higher seed. The final tie breaker will be a coin toss.
- USA Hockey certified Referees will be used to officiate games.
- All teams must be ready to play at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled game time. Games may begin up to 30 minutes prior to scheduled game time.
- All games will begin with a 5 minute warm-up. Games will be three 15 minute stop periods.
- Each team will have one 30 second time out available per game if requested.
- The games in this marathon are non-checking
- Any player that receives 3 penalties in one game will be ejected from that game. A player that receives more than 8 penalties during the tournament will be suspended from the rest of the tournament. Otherwise, USA hockey rules for adult league games will be used
